SUBJECT: ADDITIONAL RESTRICTIONS TO NIGHT OPERATIONS

Pursuant to Operations Bulletins #04-03-11 and #04-06-004, Night Flight Restrictions in effect at Toronto Pearson International Airport apply to all aircraft. Limits have been placed on the total number of flights which may occur between 0030 and 0630 L to ensure that the number of flights during the night restricted hours remains proportionate to overall traffic levels. The Greater Toronto Airports Authority (GTAA) will carefully manage the number of flights within the restricted hours and will not exceed these limits.

Be advised, the number of nighttime operations remaining is limited until the new accounting period begins on November 1, 2004. Daily limits are being placed on the number of extensions and other operations that will be allowed during the restricted hours in order to keep the numbers of flights within the yearly budget. Operating requests may be denied if they exceed the daily limit and/or we approach the annual allowance. Requests must be made to the Airport Duty Manager's office (905-676-3030) on the day of operation only. Requests in advance of the Day of Operation will not be entertained.

All aircraft operating within the restricted hours without the explicit permission of the GTAA will be subject to enforcement action under Canadian Aviation Regulation 602.105.
