Intermediate Systems Analyst

Reporting to the Senior Manager, Production Services, the incumbent is responsible for: supporting and maintaining packaged application systems and in-house developed application systems; analysing, developing, testing and implementing modifications to packages to meet user requirements; evaluating computerized systems and developing system proposals, estimates and project plans. The incumbent will also provide in-house training and troubleshooting; analyse, review, and resolve problems in the operation of package and in-house software; gather requirements, advise and recommend solutions to users; and liaise with software vendors and external consultants on problems and improvements to meet GTAA requirements. The incumbent will also provide technical expertise and skills to project implementations; co-ordinate system implementation projects with end-users; and lead small technical and user groups in all phases of the systems development life cycle. Under direction of IT Managers, Project Managers and Senior Systems Analysts, the incumbent will provide business process re-engineering functions including business case development, feasibility studies, requirements analysis and data/process modelling. The work requires moving, lifting, and crawling when installing or inspecting, and supports a seven (7) day a week, 24 hour operation.

The successful candidate will possess a degree in Computer Science from an accredited University or equivalent College degree. The successful candidate will have five (5) years experience in the computing industry in a systems development or support role, two to three years experience with SQL and PL/SQL, in addition to experience in airport operations and business administration systems such as Windows and UNIX Operating systems, Networking Communications and Internet.
