### Webmaster (1 Year Assignment)

Reporting to the Manager, Corporate Information Services, the incumbent will be responsible for: providing guidance as the corporate centre of excellence for web services governance (policies, procedures, and guidelines) including assisting with strategy development for long-range plans on GTAA's web presence both internally and externally; advising build team (internally and externally) on programming web applications in languages, such as Visual Basic, C#, Cold Fusion, JAVA, JavaScript, XML, XSL, CSS, Flash and HTML; databases such as SQL 2000 and Oracle and their user integration with user interfaces; operating system and web server administration; Web 2.0, B2B, developing web applications; coordinating contractor activities as they relate to the public website; maintaining and creating corporate content and web pages for internal and external webs, which includes designing graphic elements for screen; designing and developing databases SQL 2000 and Oracle; designing front-end solutions to integrate with existing databases; authorizing or performing operating system and web server administration; managing Domain Name administration; performing and translating web analysis; developing training plans and course materials; conducting training on corporate applications; troubleshooting and assisting with resolving technical issues for end users in the event that problems occur such as site outages and connectivity issues with the flight information database by engaging the appropriate parties to resolve the issues and to ensure that the site is reliable; acting as back up for the other members of the Corporate Information Services Team; and performing other related duties as required.

In addition, he/she must have a minimum of five (5) years of web-mastering experience in web design, development, maintenance, administration and support for a large organization, as well as having experience in managing sub-contractors.
