

QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED BY THE POSITION

EDUCATION REQUIRED:

- High School Diploma
- Graduated from Canadian Police Agency

EXPERIENCE REQUIRED:

- Several years experience in a policing environment
- Several years experience as a dog handler

ON CALL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- A commitment was made to the GTAA to provide immediate response capability 24 hours a days, 365 days of the year, thus members must be prepared to work long hours and be available at all times when designated on call to respond when requested by AOCC (Airport Operations Control Center)
- Provisions of support and assistance during airport emergencies as directed by the airport Duty Manager
- Physical effort required
- Work required driving a vehicle and walking. Obviously the handling and care of the assigned canine both on and off duty is a large responsibility

WORKING CONDITIONS:

- The employee is exposed to all weather conditions, to fumes, noise, dust, dirt, as well as potentially dangerous situations when responding to bomb threats and serious items. Further, there is always an element of risk when handling explosives in relation to training purposes.

Shift work is required, with the potential for response to airport at any hour
