- Anaphylaxis/Allergic Reaction
- Acute Cardiogenic Pulmonary Edema
- LOC – Suspected Hypoglycemia

## Symptom Relief Medication

- Glucagon
- Glucose Gel
- Nitroglycerin
- Epinephrine
- Ventolin
- ASA
