GTAA APPEARS BEFORE MISSISSAUGA COUNCIL

TORONTO—Toby Lennox, Vice President, Corporate Affairs for the Greater Toronto Airports Authority (GTAA) will be appearing this morning before the City of Mississauga Council.

Mr. Lennox will be commenting on the Economic Development Study that was developed by the GTAA in partnership with the City of Mississauga. The objective of this study was to find ways in which the GTAA and local municipalities could work together to generate economic activity. Mr. Lennox also will highlight opportunities where the City and GTAA can work together to foster economic development. In particular, Mr. Lennox will focus on issues of mutual interest to the City and Airport, including enhanced transit connecting the airport, increased Global connectivity for Mississauga through Pearson, as well as other economic development opportunities.

The GTAA is the non-share, not for profit authority that operates Toronto Pearson. All revenue generated by the GTAA is reinvested back into the airport. In 2007, 31.5 million passengers travelled through Toronto Pearson.
